### NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPROVE A SECURITY ACCESS RESTRICTION FOR SECURITY REASONS

Notice is hereby given that the City of Johannesburg, Pursuant to the provision of Chapter 7 of the Rationalization of Local Government Affairs Act, 1998, has considered and intends to grant the security access restriction applied for by the Glenluce South Security Residents Association Ref 106 and thereto authorises the Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA) to further manage the process and resultant administrative processes of the intended approval.

The positions of the access restrictions are as follows:

24-hour manned boom:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Glenluce Drive at its intersection with Leslie Avenue</li></ul>
24 hour Pedestrian Gate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Glenluce Drive at its intersection with Leslie Avenue</li></ul>

Further particulars relating to the application as well as a plan indicating the proposed closure may be inspected during normal office hours at the JRA (PTY) Ltd offices, at the address below.

The public is duly advised that in terms of the City's policy relating to these restrictions, No person/guard is permitted to deny any other person or vehicle access to or through any roads that are a subject of this approval. No person/guard is entitled to request or demand proof of identification or to sign any register as a condition to access to an area. Any violation to the conditions of approval (as detailed in the approval documents) for the permit will result in restriction permit being revoked.
