Resumption of Competitive Bid Process

Following the phased easing of national lockdown restrictions from Level 4 to Level 3 by government, the City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality, will resume procurement of goods and services through open competitive bid processes with effect from Tuesday 09 June 2020.

In compliance with the provisions of the Level 3 lockdown restrictions, all RFQ or RFP must specify that:

1. Bidders or their representatives depositing bids into the tender box will be subjected to temperature check using medical infrared forehead thermometer, at the entrance of the Metro Centre or any such designated place
2. Bidders or their representatives depositing bids into the tender box will be sanitized at the entrance of the Metro Centre or any such designated place
3. Bids/Quotations should be packaged in a way that will not be destroyed by all forms of sanitizing/disinfecting
4. In keeping with the requirement for social and physical distancing, and to avoid congestion, bidders or their representatives will be required to queue, one and half metres apart, and wait for their turn to deposit bid documents. Due to the foregoing requirement, bidders or their representatives may experience delays and should therefore plan and give themselves sufficient time to submit bids, in order to avoid missing the stipulated bid closing times. The City will not be liable for failure to deposit bids within the stipulated times, even if the bidders or their representatives were already on the queue before closing time.
5. In line with standard practice, bidders can still download the tender document or procure such from the City. Those procuring tender documents from the City will be subjected to basically the same protocol above.
6. There shall not be any compulsory briefing sessions.
7. Goods or services not allowed under Level 3 shall not be advertised.
